## Register to vote in time to have a say in the kind of future you want for your children and your community.

This year, all 120 State House seats and 21 of 40 Senate Seats are up for election in Florida. As parents, early learning providers, educators, and advocates, we all have the power to make our voices heard on early childhood issues and elect leaders who will make decisions on eligibility and funding for projects and initiatives for you and your children.

## How To Vote

### On Election Day

- You MUST vote at your designated precinct.

### Early Voting

- Early voting must be available at least 10 days before election day, during which you can vote at any precinct in your county. Check your local supervisor of elections website for your county's dates.
  - Primary Early Voting: August 10 to 17
  - General Election Early Voting: October 26 to November 2

### Vote by Mail

- You must submit a request to your county Supervisor of Elections either by mail, email, in person, or over the phone at least 12 days before the date of the election in which you plan to vote.
  - For your ballot to be counted, it must arrive by mail before 7 pm on election day or be put in a designated drop box at an early voting site or at the Supervisor of Elections' office.
