Autism Spectrum Disorder is a neurological disorder that includes problems communicating and interacting with others, unusual patterns of behavior and intellectual disability.

Boys are 4 times more likely to be diagnosed than girls, though **girls are often diagnosed and receive intervention later than boys.**

Early detection and diagnosis is vital for the best outcomes for children. Early intervention can help to adjust underlying brain development and activity.
