- Potential design projects include:

 - Logos and imagery for campaigns in different departments
 - Advertisement for The Movement
 - Agendas
 - Meeting Packets

- Strong design skills, interpersonal skills, and ability to work within a team
- Must be enrolled in a relevant undergraduate, graduate or post-graduate academic program

The Children's Movement of Florida does NOT provide housing or transportation. Academic credit may be offered. This role is part-time, 20 hours a week. It is unpaid but will be given an honorarium of \$500/month.
